Luke 3:16 - Jesus will Baptize you with the Holy Spirit and Fire

Luke 3:21-23 The Holy Spirit came upon Jesus, Jesus was affirmed by His Father, and then ministry began with Him being full of the Holy Spirit

Luke 4:1-2 Jesus was full of the Holy Spirit and led by the Spirit

Luke 4:18-19 Reveals the purpose of the fullness of the Spirit was to be anointed to proclaim good news, liberty, recovery of sight, freedom to the oppressed, & to proclaim favor

The Disciples Receive Salvation

John 20:21-22 The disciples received salvation because Jesus breathed on them and said receive the Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:9 Reveals that if you have the Holy Spirit within you, you are saved.

The Holy Spirit Empowerment Promised & Received

Luke 24:49 Jesus commanded the disciples to go to Jerusalem to wait to be clothed with Holy Spirit power

Acts 1:4 He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem but to wait for the promised Holy Spirit

Acts 1:5 Relates John's Baptism with water but the Holy Spirit's baptism was coming in days

Acts 1:8 The last words of Jesus before His ascension. He reveals that the key to taking the gospel to the world is through having the Holy Spirit come upon making you witnesses everywhere

Acts 2:1-4 The promised Holy Spirit empowerment received on the day of Pentecost

Other Baptism of the Holy Spirit occurrences: Acts 8:12-18, Acts 9:17-19, Acts 10:44-48, & Acts 19:1-6

Four Different Types of Tongues

1. *Tongues as a sign for the unbeliever(public use) - 1 Corinthians 14:22, Acts 2*
2. *Tongues for interpretation(public use)- 1 Corinthians 12:10, 1 Corinthians 1:13,27,28*
3. *Tongues for Personal Prayer(private use) - 1 Corinthians 14:2,14,& 15, Jude 20*
4. *Tongues for Intercession/Prayer for others(private use). Romans 8:26-27*

1. *Tongues the Initial Sign of the Baptism of the Holy Spirit - Acts 2:4; Acts 10:46, & Acts 19:6*
2. *Tongues for Spiritual Edification - 1 Corinthians 14:4*
3. *Tongues Remind Us of the Spirit's Indwelling Presence - John 14:16,17*
4. *Praying in Tongues Will Keep Our Prayers In Line With God's Will - Romans 8:26; 1 Corinthians 14:14*
5. *Praying in Tongues Stimulates Faith - Jude 20*
6. *Praying in Tongues Keeps Us Free From Worldly Condemnation - 1 Cor. 14:27,28*
7. *Praying in Tongues Enables Us to Pray for the Unknown - 1 Corinthians 14:2*
8. *Praying in Tongues Gives Spiritual Refreshing - Isaiah 28:11,12*
9. *Tongues For Giving Thanks - 1 Corinthians 14:15-17*
10. *Speaking in Tongues Brings the Tongue Under Subjection - James 3:8*
